# DOGÓN COUNTRY

Bamako-Djenné-País Dogón  
Departure: August 2010

**6** Arrival in BAMAKO. Transfer to our hotel.

**7** Transfer to DJENNÉ. This ancient adobe city abounds with beautiful examples of "Sudanese architecture". Its mosque (World Heritage site) is spectacular. Night in a hotel.

**8** 4x4 drive to DJIGUIBOMBO village in Dogon Country. Night in *campament* (accommodation with terraces fitted with mosquito netting, where travellers sleep on mattresses).

**9** Trekking in Dogon Country: DJIGUIBOMBO - OGOSOGU - ENDE. Night in a *campament*

**10** Trekking through WALIA to YABATALOU. Night in a *campament*.

**11** Trekking, INDIELOU village to GOLOMBO. Night in a *campament*.

**12** Trekking, GUIMINIY, YAWA Y MIDIKONSSOGO VILLAGES TO DOUROU. Transfer by 4X4 to Bandiagara. Night in a hotel.

**13** Transfer to BAMAKO. Visit the National Museum. Night in a hotel.

**14** Transfer to the airport

## USEFUL DETAILS

> **VACCINATION:**  
• Yellow fever

> **COMPULSORY MATERIAL**

- Passport
- International de vaccination certificate for yellow fever (consult your regional centre for international vaccinations)
- 2 passport photos
- Anti-malaria tablets
- Water purification tablets

- Suitable trekking footwear (take it on the plane with you for safety's sake in case your luggage is lost)
- Sleeping sheet
- Hat, sun cream and lip screen.
- Small personal first-aid kit which should contain at least: rehydration and anti-diarrhoea remedies, disinfectant, antibiotics, insect repellent and insect bite lotion.
- Headlamp or torch and replacement battery

• Neutral soap.

> **OTHER MATERIAL**

- Clothes peg to remove spiky seeds from clothes
  - A good book to read on the boat
  - A little vacuum-sealed food
  - MONEY: the currency in Mali is the west African Franc (CFA). 1 euro= 656 CFA
- You can exchange money at Bamako airport and at any bank.



## PRACTICAL DETAILS

> **FLIGHTS TO BAMAKO**

Each traveller must pay for their own flight. In any case, the meeting point for travellers who catch a different flight will be Bamako airport at 18:30 hours on August 6.

> **TRIP DETAILS:** Mali is an astonishing country with abounding attractions. Unfortunately, it is also a country with a serious shortage of material resources, which makes it more necessary than ever to embark on this journey with an open mind. On our trek through Dogon Country, we will be accompanied by our guide, a cook and the staff responsible for the donkey and cattle-drawn carts which will carry the material and your luggage, so you must keep it to a minimum. Each traveller should carry a small day rucksack on the 5-6 hour walking sections. A 4x4 vehicle is always on hand to ensure a quick response to any un-

ward event in Dogon Country, although initially we will not need to use it. You can leave any luggage not required for the trekking section in the vehicle.

> **COST PER PERSON:**

**1.100 €**

Groups of 4 to 11 pax.

Includes travel insurance, visa, transport, fuel, accommodation, everything necessary for the trek and the pinasse journey, local guide, all meals except for those in cities. Flight, drinks and climatitiation at the hotels are not included.
