14H: MEETING POINT AT MARRAKESH AIRPORT. DRIVE TO DASSAR (3 H). Dassar is a small coastal village. From here we can visit Dassar beach, the sheltered Imikro cove and Ifthane, another beach that is home to a fishing community. Night in tents.

IN THE AFTERNOON, WE FOLLOW THE COAST TO SIDI IFNI (4 H). Nights 2 and 3 are in centrally located apartments, allowing us to mingle with the city's nightlife.

For Spanish travellers, Sidi ifni is a re-encounter with their history in the heart of Morocco: public buildings built under the former Spanish administration, streets that seem to have come straight from Badajoz or Ceuta, etc.

WE CONTINUE SOUTH TO PLAGÉ BLANCHE (3H). Arriving at this 40 km long beach is an unforgettable experience. Night in tents.

WE HEAD INTO THE ANTI ATLAS TO THE TAFRAOUT REGION (4H). Accommodation is an old family home, beautifully transformed into a country hotel. Its location in the heart of the mountains is spectacular.

WE RETURN TO THE COAST TO THE SOUSS MASSA NATIONAL PARK (3H) Night in fishermen's caves and tents.

7

WE CONTINUE UP THE COAST TO ESSAOUIRA (2H). Apartment accommodation in the residential zone.

DAY 8, RETURN TO MARRAKESH

Southern Morocco's Atlantic coast is nature in its pure state: wild beaches spreading for dozens of miles and secluded coves pitted with caves used by fishermen, which give way inland to the western section of the Atlas Mountains. Here, a tree that is exclusive to this territory, the Argan, is a source of wealth on account of the oil extracted from its fruit.

When townships dripping with history, meals of freshly caught fish and an atmosphere where you can hear the murmur of the Sahara are added to all of this natural beauty, the result is an unforgettable journey.

>TRIP SPECIFICATIONS: At Kasbah Itran we prefer to use accommodation provided by the local population which has a light 'ecological footprint' on the area. This is a particularly important decision in this area, where the avarice of large Western construction companies and the lack of a future vision by small local entrepreneurs is threatening its valuable natural heritage. On this journey, we will experience the thrill of waking up in the morning in the midst of wild beaches as well as the satis-

There is more comfortable accommodation, but if it has been built at the expense of the landscape and the local architecture, we prefer not to use it. On our journey, we will be accompanied by a local guide and a chef. The minimum group size is 4 and the ma-

ximum is 10.

> COMPULSORY MATERIAL

• VALID PASSPORT, sleeping bag, hat, sunscreen and lip balm, warm clothing, headlamp or torch.
